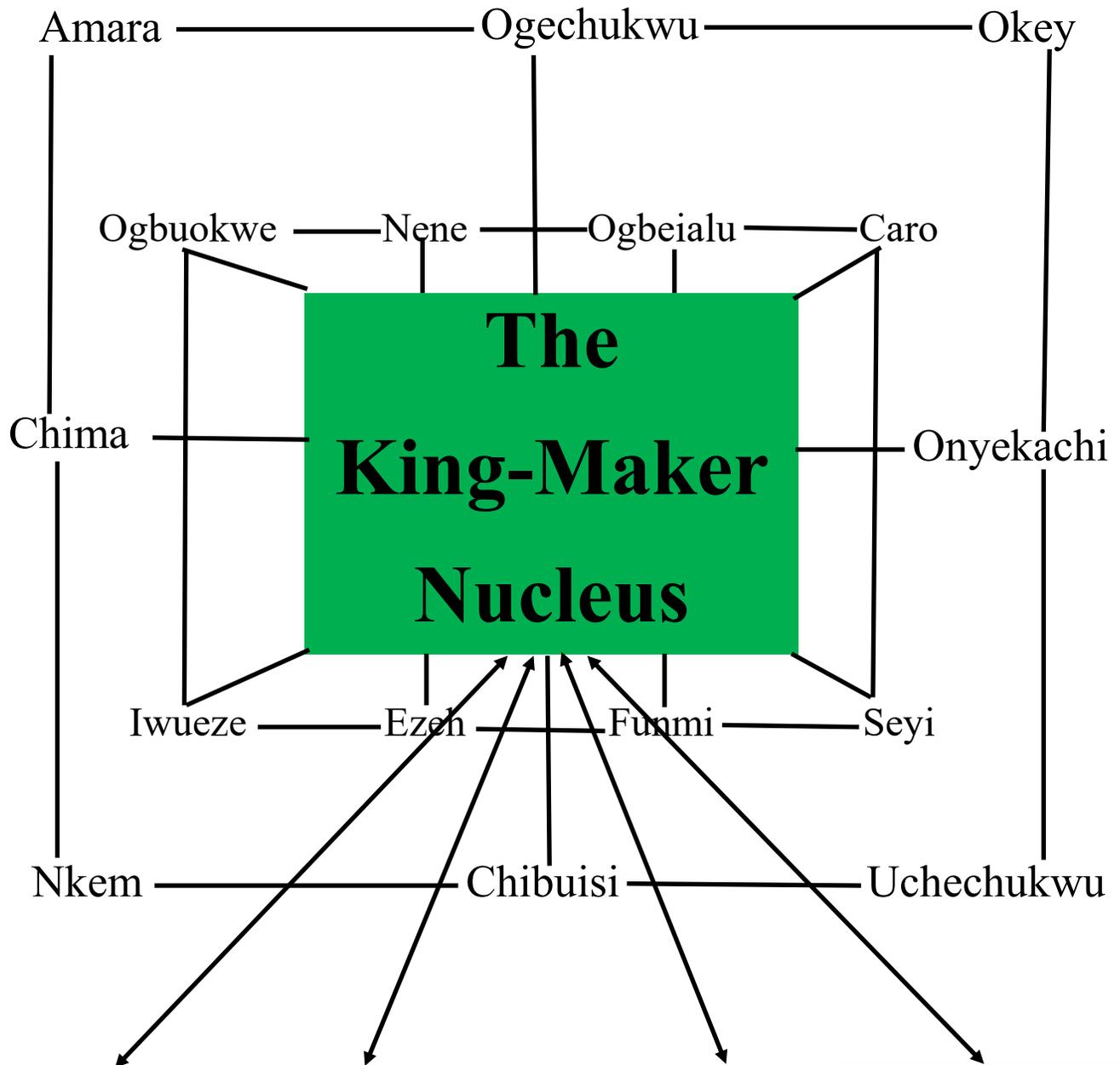


## Zombification


