Role-Play

ROLE-PLAY SCENARIO

Role-play approach with this scenario: You are a Behavioral Health Consultant presenting to the leadership of a primary care clinic networks proposal for a population health management project for CHD and Depression (inclusive of health assessments, outcomes measures, evidence-based treatments, and ROI). Attendees include the Chief Medical Officer, Primary Care Physician leaders, and a Quality Improvement department representative.

Role-Play Presentation Scenario

Setting: A conference room in a primary care clinic network. The Chief Medical Officer (CMO), Primary Care Physician leaders, and a representative from the Quality Improvement department will attend.

Felicia Chika Harrison Behavioral Health Consultant:

Good morning, everyone! Thank you for joining me today. I am excited to present a proposal for a population health management project focused on managing Coronary Heart Disease (CHD) and Depression, two conditions that often coexist and significantly impact our patients' health outcomes.

Slide 1: Introduction

As we know, CHD and depression are prevalent in our patient population, particularly among low-income families in urban areas. These conditions affect individual health and contribute to increased healthcare costs and reduced quality of life (Kindig & Stoddart, 2003). We aim to implement a comprehensive approach that addresses physical and behavioral health needs.

Slide 2: Health Assessments

To start, we propose conducting thorough health assessments that include screenings for both CHD and depression. These assessments will help us identify and stratify at-risk individuals based on their specific health needs. Integrating behavioral health screenings into routine primary care visits will ensure we address the whole patient (Woolf & Aron, 2013).

Slide 3: Evidence-Based Treatments

Next, we will implement evidence-based treatments tailored to the needs identified in our assessments. For CHD, this may include lifestyle modifications and medication management, while for depression, we can offer cognitive-behavioral therapy (CBT) and other therapeutic interventions. Research indicates that integrated care models improve treatment adherence and patient satisfaction (Buckle et al., 2019).

Slide 4: Outcomes Measures

To evaluate the effectiveness of our project, we will track several key outcomes:

Reduction in hospital readmissions related to CHD

Improvement in depression screening scores

Enhanced patient satisfaction ratings

These measures will be assessed over two years to determine our interventions' impact (NCQA, 2021).

Slide 5: Return on Investment (ROI)

Finally, let us discuss the financial implications. We project a return on investment of at least 3:1, based on reduced healthcare costs associated with preventable complications and increased productivity from healthier individuals. Investing in this population health management project can save significant costs while improving health outcomes (CDC, 2020).

Slide 6: Conclusion

In conclusion, this project represents a strategic opportunity to enhance our clinic's capacity to manage our patients' health holistically. By addressing increase patient satisfaction, and achieve a strong ROI.

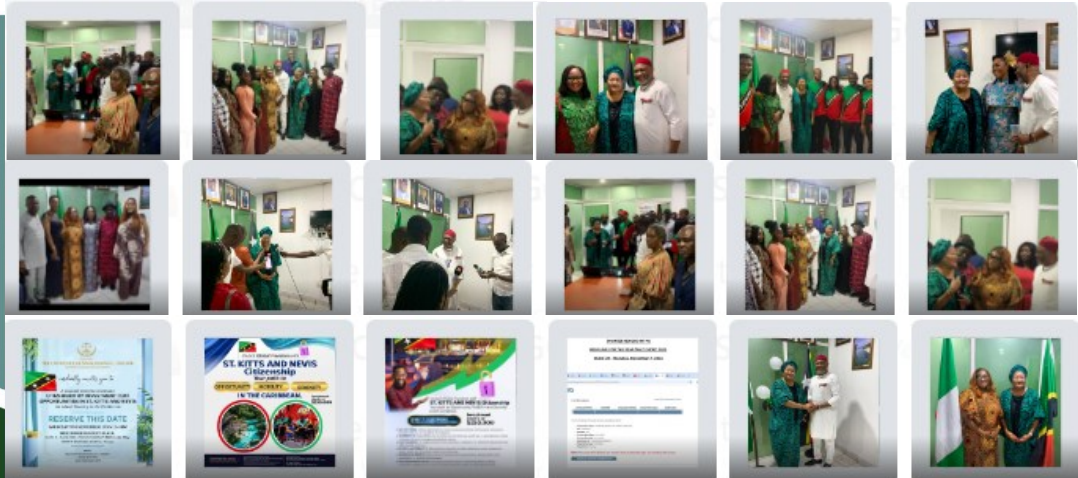

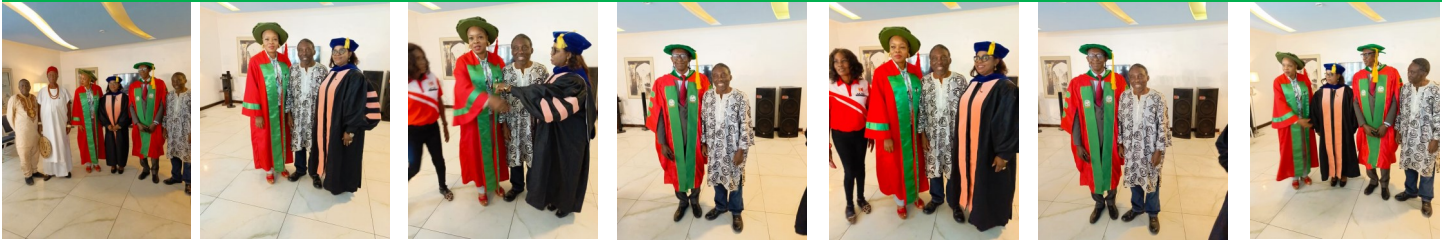
Guess a U.S. Nuclear Scientist

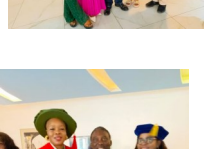

Center for Academic Research and Educational Sustainability (C.A.R.E.S.)

Emmanuel University has this knack to combine research with its 'functional educational' paradigm. Ordinarily, one would expect that the emphasis the university places on practical skills would remove its attention from research. Unfortunately, the caliber of the university's faculty warrants full-blast engagement with social science research. To buttress the extend to which the university combines research with practical or functional education, the institution has found a researcher in Africa who is engaged in the processing of Cassava into Vitamin A products. The university decided to offer the researcher a sabbatical leave that he will spend in the United States to work with the appropriate laboratories for the purposes of publishing the research and exploring other Cassava and Vitamin A outcomes.

Faculty Training Program

The Emmanuel University School of Education is offering (again) the prestigious Online Faculty Training in which individuals with doctorate degree holders pursue and earn a post-doctoral certificate in Education while those with master's degrees pursue and earn post-master's certificate in Education. It is an intensive one-year program under the university's Faculty Training Program (FTP). Typical teaching training programs offer one term of teaching practice. At Emmanuel University School of Education, the Faculty Training Program deploys OFT enrollees to bachelor degree program courserooms where they will spend the whole one year practicing what they are learning in the OFT courseroom. Thus, enrollees are 'students' in the OFT courseroom and 'faculty' in the Practicing School doing their year-long teaching practice. This design does not exist anywhere else in the world.
