



Arguably, entrepreneurship is the magic wind with prospects that can bring success to youth and society at large and can change the narratives (Adeola and Ozigbo, 2021). Certainly youths can benefit from government sponsored engagements to engender entrepreneurial growth because Nigeria's most significant resource is its youth, constituting approximately 70% of the entire Nigeria's Population and not oil resources (Abimbola, Olowu, and Paul, 2016). Poverty and Unemployment Still Plaque Nigeria because of its inability in entrepreneurship.

To reduce the crises, there is a great need for entrepreneurship education for the development of skills at personal, social and professional levels.

to enhance the career development of the youths.



Apart from lack of serious government intervention in entrepreneurship, other challenges include insufficient capital, lack of focus, inadequate market research, over-concentration on one or two markets for finished products, lack of succession plan, inexperience, lack of proper book keeping, inability to separate business and family or

their career, and optimally contribute towards national development.
