





# Declaration of State of Emergency Under Section 305 of the 1999 Constitution of Nigeria

**Abstract**

*This paper examined the procedure and the circumstances under which a state of emergency can be declared in Nigeria. The study gives special reference to the provisions of section 305 of the 1999 constitution as amended. We analyzed the legal basis for the declaration of state of emergency, the duration and renewal of the emergency rule, safeguards and constitutional checks, judicial review and the opinion of scholars on the constitutional limit of the President to declare a state of emergency. The study recommended that there should be judicial clarification on the limitations of the section 305, legislative guidelines, human right protection and public accountability. This will adequately curtail executive recklessness in the application of section 305, and further strengthen the doctrine of separation of power and constitutional federalism.*

**Safeguards and Constitutional Checks**

To prevent abuse of emergency powers, the Constitution includes the following checks:

- **Legislative approval** within two days (Section 305(2));
- **Renewal** only through legislative resolution (Section 305(6));
- **Judicial review** of the legality and constitutionality of the proclamation;

**Introduction**

The power to declare a state of emergency is a constitutional mechanism that allows the executive arm of government to respond swiftly and decisively to extraordinary threats to the nation. In Nigeria, this power is provided for under Section 305 of the 1999 Constitution (as amended). It is a tool that balances executive discretion with legislative oversight, aimed at preserving national unity, security, and constitutional order.

**Legal Basis for Declaration: Section 305 of the 1999 Constitution**

Section 305 vests the President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria with the authority to declare a state of emergency via a Proclamation published in the Official Gazette, subject to legislative approval. The National Assembly (NASS) must approve the proclamation by a simple majority in both chambers within two days of the declaration (or within 10 days if the Assembly is not in session).

**Section 305(3) outlines six grounds for such a declaration:**

- War or imminent war;
  - Invasion or imminent invasion;
  - Breakdown of public order and safety;
  - Natural disaster or calamity;
  - Danger to the sovereignty or economic stability of Nigeria;
- Any other public danger threatening the existence of the country.

Additionally, under Section 305(4), a State Governor may request the President to proclaim a state of emergency in that state if there's a breakdown of public order, and the President is satisfied that such a request is justified.

**Duration and Renewal**

A state of emergency remains valid for 180 days in the first instance. It can be renewed for additional 6-month periods, subject to fresh legislative approval under Section 305 (6). The President can revoke the proclamation at any time, and the National Assembly may also pass a resolution to nullify it, section 305.

**Revocation** either by the President or National Assembly. These ensure that emergency powers do not override constitutional governance or permanently suspend democratic institutions.





# Declaration of State of Emergency Under Section 305 of the 1999 Constitution of Nigeria *(continued from Page 7)*

In each case, the justification and scope of the emergency declaration were hotly debated, especially regarding the removal or suspension of elected officials.

**Nwabueze (1982)** argues that emergency powers in Nigeria have historically been used as tools of political dominance, especially during military rule. The 1999 Constitution tries to address this by requiring legislative involvement, thus providing a check on executive overreach.

**Ojo (2000)** highlights that the broad wording of Section 305(3)(f) – “any other public danger” – may allow abuse, unless interpreted narrowly. He recommends judicial oversight of emergency declarations to prevent erosion of constitutional liberties.

**Oyewo (2009)** asserts that Nigeria’s experience with emergency powers shows a pattern of politicized use, where declarations often coincide with opposition-controlled states.

## Judicial Review

### A.G. Plateau State v. President of the FRN & Ors (2006)

The Supreme Court held that while the President has the power to declare a state of emergency, he does not have the constitutional authority to suspend or dissolve democratically elected institutions of a state, such as the Governor or State House of Assembly.

The court emphasized that Nigeria operates a federal system, and the autonomy of state institutions must be respected, even during emergencies.

However, due to the political nature of the issues and the fact that the emergency period had already lapsed, the court declined to issue orders nullifying the actions taken during the emergency. It therefore dismissed the suit, but provided clear constitutional guidance on what is permissible under a state of emergency.

### A.G. Federation v. A.G. Abia State (2002) 6 NWLR (Pt. 763) 264

In this case, the Supreme Court emphasized that federalism and constitutionalism must guide the exercise of the powers of the executive. While the federal government has overriding authority in emergencies through executive orders, it must respect constitutional limits and procedures.

## Conclusion

Section 305 provides a constitutional mechanism for the preservation of national security and order in extraordinary circumstances. While it rightly grants the President emergency powers, these must be used with caution, under strict constitutional guidelines, and subject to oversight by both the National Assembly and the judiciary. Abuse of this provision risks undermining federalism, human rights, and democratic governance.

## Recommendations

**1. Judicial Clarification** – The Supreme Court of Nigeria should, through judicial interpretation, clearly delimit the scope of Section 305, especially the residual clause of “any other public danger,” to prevent abuse.

**2. Legislative Guidelines** – The National Assembly should enact a framework law outlining detailed criteria for assessing emergency situations, providing objective benchmarks for legislative approval or rejection.

**3. Federalism Safeguards** – The Constitution should be amended to expressly prohibit the dissolution or suspension of elected state officials during a state of emergency, reinforcing the principle that federal intervention does not equate to takeover.

**4. Human Rights Protection** – Clear protocols should be established to guide permissible derogations of rights under Section 45(3) in conformity with Nigeria’s obligations under the African Charter on Human and Peoples’ Rights and the ICCPR.

**Public Accountability** – Civil society and the media should play an enhanced role in monitoring and reporting emergency declarations to ensure transparency and prevent the normalization of exceptional measures.

# Pastor Kristie Prince's Pulpit




